

RECOMMENDATION ON GASTRIC CANCER SCREENING


Screening for Helicobacter pylori should be considered in those countries or regions inside countries with high gastric cancer incidence and death rates, according to thresholds to be defined in European guidelines with quality assurance. Screening should also address strategies for identification and surveillance of patients with precancerous stomach lesions unrelated to Helicobacter pylori infections. Considering the evidence for screening and the need for a stepwise approach, countries should begin to test the feasibility of this programme, including by using implementation studies.





- TOGAS Pilot Study 1: Implementation research of *Screen and treat strategy* in young-age individuals
- Age group: 30-35 years
- 6,800 subjects to be recruited

TOGAS Pilot Study 2: Endoscopic Screening

- Screening for gastric cancer and for conditions indicating an increased risk for gastric cancer in different European countries
- Age group: 50-74 years
- Observational diagnostic study
- 1,800 subjects to be recruited in 7 centres
- Study population: subjects presenting for colorectal cancer / polyp screening or surveillance


